John 1.19-28

<sup>19</sup> This is the testimony of John, when the Jews sent to him priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, "Who are you?" <sup>20</sup> And he confessed and did not deny, but confessed, "I am not the Christ." <sup>21</sup> They asked him, "What then? Are you Elijah?" And he \*said, "I am not." "Are you the Prophet?" And he answered, "No." <sup>22</sup> Then they said to him, "Who are you, so that we may give an answer to those who sent us? What do you say about yourself?" <sup>23</sup> He said, "I am a voice of one crying in the wilderness, 'Make straight the way of the Lord,' as Isaiah the prophet said."

<sup>24</sup> Now they had been sent from the Pharisees. <sup>25</sup> They asked him, and said to him, "Why then are you baptizing, if you are not the Christ, nor Elijah, nor the Prophet?" <sup>26</sup> John answered them saying, "I baptize in water, but among you stands One whom you do not know. <sup>27</sup> It is He who comes after me, the thong of whose sandal I am not worthy to untie." <sup>28</sup> These things took place in Bethany beyond the Jordan, where John was baptizing.
